Ellie Murphy, 15 Plaza Drive, Newton, NJ - Asked the Board if they were aware of a news article published today NJ Herald title "Embattled Montague superintendent on leave sues board members for retaliation" and the article stated "this board was contemplating filing tenure charges against him". If this is true she commends the Board for trying to remove this character from education. Montague is not his first victim. His employment history is riffed with all kinds of controversy. If not familiar with background Goggle Timothy C. Capone, Delaware, Timothy C. Capone, Trenton, NJ, Timothy C. Capone, Newark, NJ, Timothy C. Capone, Highland Park, NJ and our local paper the NJ Herald. This man has left a wake of destruction wherever he has been. Montague parents, school staff and students have suffered tremendously under this man's leadership style. This Board seems to be doing an outstanding job to return the school back to a normal, vibrant, happy place. Thank you Montague Board for not sending this man onto his next project.

Joseph Garcia, Esq., thanked Ms. Murphy for her comments and stated the following:

"There is a lot that I'm sure the board would like to say. They have been advised by me that we don't comment on pending litigation and I can tell you that we certainly look forward to defending ourselves and letting the process play out. The only thing I do want to mention and I do not think it is related to litigation and I did have an opportunity to read the article today and I thought the information was gratuitous and that it was not necessary to be in there and unrelated to the litigation. There was something in there about allegations that a former employee made against a current employee and some of you might recall that many months ago someone came to the stand. There was a big production here. We had video cameras here, building plans. The individual made some allegations against one of our employees. As is our obligation, we tried to do an investigation. Mary Kate Serratelli, my law partner from my office, reached out to her multiple times to try to get her to sit down with us and cooperate so that we can do an investigation. She refused time after time to cooperate in the investigation to provide any information and there was no other evidence to corroborate those charges. As a result they could not be sustained and the matter was closed. I did want to address that because again I thought it was an unnecessary and gratuitous line in that article today. Other than that we are not going to comment on the litigation."

Barbara Holstein thanked Joseph Garcia, Esq., for his comment and making that clarification on the public record.
