#### **Unfinished Business**

Mrs. Cole asked about the status of the residency audit. Mr. Capone reported that he and his executive assistant went through the report; only one student in question at this time.

Transportation – all routes have been submitted. Ms. Johnson reported parents are complaining about the routes being changed/re-rerouted.

Mrs. Cole – questioned the status of a scanner or time-clock for staff.

Ms. Johnson questioned negotiations – Mr. Plotsky reported a one-year contract has been approved.

Ms. Johnson reported she would not use the BOE email until a new IT company comes in. Mrs. Cole said she also had some problems with using the account. Mrs. Spinapolice encouraged all to use the BOE email. Mr. Plotsky explained the issue is if there is a situation and your emails are requested for litigation or whatever other purpose - if you are using something other than provided by the school; not using the BOE email would make all of your personal emails public.

#### New Business

Mrs. Andriac questioned if Board of Education member "blind copying" other members above the allowable three-members qualifies as a quorum; is it an OPMA violation?

Three major projects need to be addressed as soon as possible; new roof, underground tank, and asbestos tiles. Mr. Capone urged the Board to consider this an urgent issue that needs immediate action.
