

Parent and Student Handbook

AWARDS

High Honor and Honor Roll (grades 4-6) are determined each marking period. Honor Roll may be published in the local paper (with parent permission).

Citizenship (grades 4-6) and Attendance awards (K-6) are given at the end of the school year. The criteria for awards are as follows:

HIGH HONOR ROLL

- A grade of 93 or higher in the four major subject areas (language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies), allowing for a grade of 85 or higher in the remaining subject areas.
- A grade of "S" or higher in effort and conduct

HONOR ROLL

- A grade of 85 or higher in all subject areas.
- A grade of "S" or higher in effort and conduct.
