Any change of transportation plans should be in writing the day of the change and presented to the advisor by your child.

All students in grades 6-8 who participate in intramural school sports must have a physical exam done within 365 days of the start of the sport. This exam must be completed on the 4 page NJ State Department of Education's Approved Intramural Sports Forms found on the school website. (Have your child check with the school nurse if you think a current physical is already on file.) Once these forms are received at Montague, they need to go to our SCHOOL PHYSICIAN for clearance. This process may take a week or more. Your child will not be able to participate until cleared by our SCHOOL PHYSICIAN. The following information sheets must be read and the form stating that you have read them must be signed by both a parent/guardian and your child: concussions, sudden cardiac death in student athletes and eye injury.

*** NJ State Sports Physical Forms are valid for ONE CALENDAR YEAR (365 days) from the DATE OF EXAM, - NOT FROM THE DATE THE FORMS WERE FILLED OUT.

If your child's physical exam was done more than 90 days before the start of the sport, a separate Health History Update Questionnaire must be completed (also found on the district /school website).

Students in grade 5 will only need a regular physical exam and documented on a simple, one page physical exam form, also found on our school website homepage. All other forms in the sports folder must be read, signed where appropriate and returned to the school nurse prior to the start of the intramural sport.
